01. Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance

Meeting called to order at 9:30 A.M. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

02. Public Comment(s)

Flamingo Villas: Ms. Shirley Kaplan, HOA President, and Mr. Patrick Tyler, management company rep, requested financial assistance for the repair of some seawalls which will cost \$26,540. After the FEMA issue is resolved, this can be further discussed.

- 03. Meeting Minutes** - (A) January 11, 2007, Board meeting minutes approved unanimously per motion by Mr. Goggin and second by Ms. Mersinger. (B) January 25, 2007, Board meeting minutes approved unanimously per motion by Ms. Mersinger and second by Mr. Goggin.

04. SFWMD C-11 Recreational Grant/Flamingo Road To I-75/SWR

At the request of SWR, motion by Ms. Mersinger and second by Mr. Ryan to support the grant from SFWMD to SWR approved unanimously.

05. SWR Fire-Station Parking At S-8 Pump Station Site

SWR has requested an emergency parking area south of the District's S-8 Pump Station structure. If ever needed, the property would revert back to SBDD. Motion to approve by Ms. Mersinger, second by Mr. Goggin and carried by unanimous voice vote.

06. Variance/Vacation Requests

A. Bianco (11340 NW 23 Street, Pembroke Pines): Motion by Mr. Ryan to defer this tree-variance request until the March 29th Board meeting. Second by Ms. Mersinger. Carried unanimously.

B. Hitchcock (18516 NW 18 Street, Pembroke Pines): Motion by Mr. Ryan to defer this tree-variance request until the March 29th Board meeting. Second by Mr. Lanke; carried unanimously. It was understood that the ficus hedge must be removed.

C. Woodbury (11270 NW. 21 Street, Pembroke Pines): Motion by Ms. Mersinger to defer this tree-variance request until the March 29th Board meeting. Second by Mr. Ryan; carried unanimously. It was understood that the electric will be removed from the dock area.

D. Leik (18010 NW 15 Court, Pembroke Pines): Motion by Ms. Mersinger to defer this tree-variance request until the March 29th Board meeting. Second by Mr. Ryan; carried unanimously

E. Fisikelli (16700 NW 68 Street, Southwest Ranches): Mr. Fred Fisikelli is opposed to having to dedicate a canal and drainage easement along his west property line during

the District's level-of-service review of the guest house Mr. Fisikelli wishes to construct on said property. Mr. Fisikelli agreed that if the District acquired all the easements needed to dig a canal, he would agree to grant the needed easements on his property. Ms. Mersinger moved that Mr. Bell endeavor to create an agreement that would be acceptable to the District and Mr. Fisikelli and then come back to the Board for further action on the issue. Second by Mr. Goggin; carried unanimously.

07. Alternative Tax-Method Analysis Report

Mr. Schwartzberg's alternative tax-method analysis report (copy attached) was discussed. Due to the great importance of this issue, it was agreed to have a one-item Management Committee meeting for discussion and determination on how to proceed.

08. FEMA-Appeal Update

There will be a meeting next week with a FEMA rep and the Beck consultant, along with Mr. Schwartzberg, which will be another step toward moving to a "good" resolution of the District's request for FEMA funds to be used to defray some of the District's cost on the erosion-repair project Phase 1. Signs indicate this effort will be successful.

09. Funds Transfer/Erosion

Mr. Schwartzberg requested approval to transfer a total of \$1,422,600.66, from various accounts to cover the cost for the final interim-erosion work (funds-transfer memo attached). Motion by Mr. Ryan to approve request as submitted. Second by Mr. Lanke; carried unanimously.

10. Weekly Property/Ditch Construction & Tree Removal

Ditch: Mr. Goggin moved to approve Craco Contracting, Inc., for the construction of ditch. Second by Mr. Ryan; carried unanimously.

Tree Removal: Mr. Ryan moved to accept the Craco Contracting, Inc., bid for tree removal. Second by Mr. Goggin; carried unanimously.

11. GRIT Insurance Check

A check for approximately \$5,000 has been received from the District's previous workers comp insurance carrier. This makes approximately \$20,000 reimbursed from monies the District had to pay when GRIT "went under".

12. Elected Officials/District Tour

Mr. Schwartzberg asked any interested SBDD Supervisors to invite any/all newly-elected City/Town officials to contact him to arrange a tour of the District.

13. Legislative Update

Mr. Bell reported that everything appears to be going smoothly with the updating/changes to the District's Charter as submitted for legislative approval..

14. Eklund/SWR Drainage-Easement Consent

SWR has asked the owner of Lot 4, Country Acres, to dedicate a drainage-easement to the Town which requires SBDD approval as it will overlap SBDD's surface-water management area. Motion by Mr. Ryan to approve. Second by Mr. Goggin; carried unanimously.

15. Adopt-A-Canal Proposed Program

The District has been requested to institute an Adopt-A-Canal Program, and all agreed this to be an excellent idea. The program will “kick off” on March 24th at the Broward County Water Matters Day affair. Mr. Ryan moved to approve Resolution 2007-02 pertaining to the “new” program. Motion seconded by Ms. Mersinger; carried unanimously.

16. Electric In Easements

Resolution #2007-03 (for improvements, including electric, on property owners property and adjacent water body) submitted for approval. Motion to approve by Mr. Ryan, second by Ms. Mersinger; carried unanimously after amendment by Mr. Goggin to include that the safety-cutoff switch be painted “safety red”.

Resolution #2007-04 (for improvements, including electric, on property owners property only w/safety-cutoff switch to be painted “safety red”) approved unanimously per motion by Ms. Mersinger, second by Mr. Goggin.

It was stressed that these resolutions (and agreements) pertain only to properties on lakes and **NOT** on canals.

17. Legal Bills

Mr. Lanke moved to approve the legal bills as submitted. Seconded by Mr. Ryan and carried unanimously.

18. Supervisors Monthly Checks

Brief discussion ensued on the Supervisors monthly stipend checks. It was agreed to make no change regarding the date of issue/distribution.

19. Public Relations

Miramar will definitely allow the District space in its newsletter. Pembroke Pines will be asked if they would permit the same. Also, new policies should be listed on the SBDD web site.

20. Supervisors E-Mail

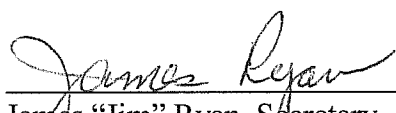
