PROJECT NAME:

70 HOUR POST STORM DEBRIS/TREE REMOVAL

LOCATIONS/DESCRIPTION: AREAS TO BE DETERMINED BY THE DISTRICT

GENERAL PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

- A. Cut/removal of all storm related trees and brush/branches from waters edge to waters edge in canals.
- B. Removal of all storm related trash and debris larger than a 1 gallon container.
- C. Remove from easements, all brush, trees and debris that restricts/blocks access to the canals.

INVITATION TO BID: Sealed Bids will be accepted until 3:00 p.m., Tuesday, May 29, 2007. The bids will be opened publicly at 3:15 p.m.

REQUIRED CRITERIA FOR CONTRACTORS:

This is a contract for up to 70 hours of work based on each crew meeting the following criteria:

- A Three (3) experienced employees with the knowledge of removal of trees, branches and trash from canals and operation of chain saws.
- B One (1) chipper truck with a minimum of 18 cubic yard capacity.
- C One (1) chipper with a minimum 12" diameter chipping capacity.
- D The contractor must have all necessary tools and supplies to remove items from water bodies (example: rope, chains, cables, chain saws).
- E The contractor must have available a bobcat, combination, crane truck, wench and boat which may be needed to assist its crew.
- F Must be available to begin work 24 hours after the storm has left the area and be available to continue working for up to 70 working hours as directed by the District.

I SCOPE OF WORK

- A Contractor to cut trees to edge of water. Root balls to be left in place.
- B Contractor to remove all cut trees, branches, brush and debris and dispose of properly as approved by the District.
- C Contractor must provide information regarding approved dump site and copy of tipping fee receipt (dump tickets).
- D Contractor must restore any damage to public or private property at the contractor's expense.
- E Contractor is responsible for clearing easements of brush, trees and debris which restrict/block access to canals and dispose of properly.

PROJECT NAME:

70 HOUR POST STORM VAC TRUCK SERVICES

LOCATIONS/DESCRIPTION: AREAS TO BE DETERMINED BY THE DISTRICT.

GENERAL PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Cleaning/channeling of stormwater structures throughout the District as required to insure movement of stormwater after a storm event.

Gender Statement: Wherever the pronoun "he" is used in this document, it refers to all genders.

INVITATION TO BID: Bids will be accepted until 3:00 p.m., Tuesday May 29, 2007. The bids will be opened publicly at 3:15 p.m.

I SCOPE OF WORK

- A Contractor will clean pipes and channel to the deep cut of the body of water. The channeling must be 6 - 12" below the invert of the pipe and on and one half (1 ½) times the diameter of the pipe. The slope of the sides of the channel shall not exceed the angle of repose.

- B Catch basins will be checked and cleaned as needed.

- C Contractor will have three (3) experienced employees with the knowledge of cleaning culverts and working in the water.

- D Contractor shall have available and be prepared to commit to this project, all equipment and material necessary to start work in the time frame specified and to complete said work in an uninterrupted manner.

- E Contractor must restore any damage to public or private property at the contractor's expense.
